

Effort Guidelines for Grant Applications

- 1) New grants must contain appropriate funded effort for the principal investigator, as outlined below, except where salary support is not allowed or limited by the funding agency.
- 2) For R01-or equivalent grants (DoD, P01, U54 or SPORE project, >\$200,000 per year in direct costs), a minimum of 30% effort must be charged to the grant if the PI does not have any additional R01-equivalent funding. For dual- or multi-PI applications, 25% effort should be charged for each principal investigator.
- 3) A minimum of 10% effort should be budgeted for program project and/or cooperative agreement (P01, U01) project leaders and core directors.
- 4) A minimum of 10% PI salary should be budgeted for grants with annual direct costs of >\$100,000 and <\$200,000 that allow salary recovery, such as NIH R21 grants and grants from private foundations.
- 5) Voluntary cost sharing of effort is prohibited. If voluntary cost shared effort is proposed, the % effort should be minimal and must be approved in advance of the eIAF being routed by the Chair/Director and the Vice Dean for Research. Cost shared effort will be allowed if specifically required by the granting agency. - 6) Any exceptions to the above guidelines must be requested in writing and approved by the Chair/Director and Vice Dean for Research prior to the routing of the eIAF.
