UNITE Predoctoral Research Enhancement Program - Call for Applications

The purpose of this mechanism is to engage racially and ethnically diverse scholars interested in an academic career with an individualized research program under the mentorship of one or more UK professors, along with research career development activities. As a UNITE Predoctoral Fellow, this stipend will supplement existing or expected funding from the Graduate School, college, or department. The UNITE Predoctoral Research Enhancement Program will provide a **\$10,000** stipend over 9 months and **\$1,000** annually to support research related expenses for selected PhD students.

Health Affairs Health Equity Fellowship for Trainees - Call for Applications

This Fellowship is part of *Health Affairs*' national initiative to <u>advance racial equity</u> in health policy and health services scholarly publishing. Its objective is to *value* and *increase the quality* and *quantity* of <u>equity-related research</u> published in *Health Affairs* authored by members of racial and ethnic groups that have historically been underrepresented in scholarly publishing. The objective is to offer fellows multi-layered mentorship from experienced *Health Affairs* authors and editorial staff for one-year (from January 2023 to December 2023). Mentors work with fellows to make manuscript submissions by fellows more likely to be published in the journal.
