Any area of microbiology research is welcome including host-microbe biology, microbial physiology, clinical diagnostics, applied and environmental microbiology, and microbiology education. The deadline for abstract submission is Fri. 10/08/21. Applicants chosen to give ten minute talks at the meeting will be notified by 10/18/21.

STUDENTS: Cultivate your scientific communication skills by effectively explaining your research project to a non-specialist audience in just three minutes. We will follow the rules as established by the founders of the original 3 Minute Thesis at Queensland Univ. (https://threeminutethesis.uq.edu.au/resources/competition-rules).
