

Most recent 501(c)(3) letter or other proof of tax exempt status



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Employer identification number & DUNS number – Required for all federal applications. May take time.

Annual Report – Do you have one?

Organization Chart and list of board members

Any recent needs assessments, program evaluation reports, and examples of forms being used

Current resumes and "biographies" (biosketches) of key staff

Most recent overall organization budget and individual program

Job descriptions for all positions – Don't forget to update as you add


List of all current funding sources and potential sources of matching

Personnel policies and procedures, updated floor plan, disaster plan

Boilerplate – a paragraph or two about when and how the organization started and significant milestones.




































Questions to ask yourself

It fits!

Does my organization fit the eligibility requirements? Is my idea a fit for this grant? (It's not reaching to fit program objectives) Can I find data on the problem? Is there someone else doing the same thing? Have they funded an organization or project similar to mine? Do we have the capacity once we get the grant? Will my idea give measurables to send back to the funder? Is this project sustainable? Do they require a match and can I provide it? Do I want/need to include partners? DO I HAVE TIME TO CREATE AND SUBMIT THIS PROPOSAL?





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
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
Before you write one word, make an outline

Double (and triple) think your choice of words




Buy a grammar book – use it when in doubt (and even when you're not in doubt)

Stick to the active voice – use the most straightforward approach.




Keep your own voice out of it – political views, humor, personal views are a no









Limit the adjectives – can be effective if limited, with explanations.
