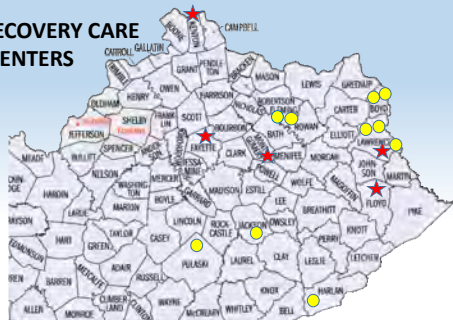
TREATMENT ON DEMAND

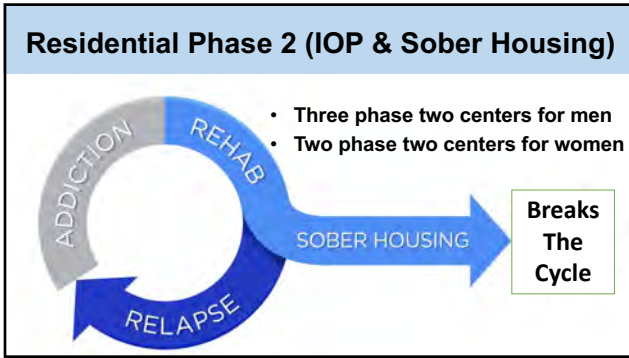


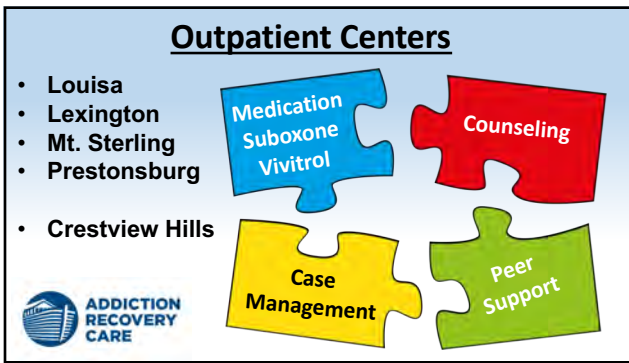

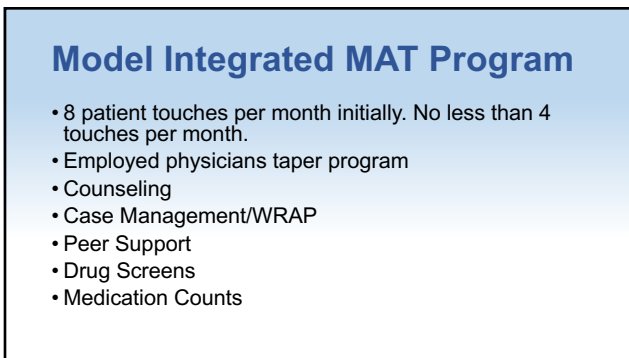


Average NICU stay for a drug addicted baby is over 20 days.

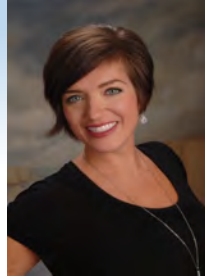

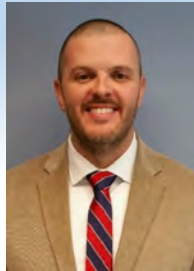

Boyd County Needle Exchange

- 17 people entered treatment in 1st year.
- A decision to enter treatment every 13.25 hours the exchange was open.
