- August 2008 resigns as prosecutor and gives law practice to partner.
- December 2010 Karen's Place, recovery center for women, opens in Louisa, Kentucky.


- Admitted first Medicaid Residential patient January 2015

- Private Insurance plans provide coverage




Average wait time for a bed for someone who has insurance and passes phone screen:









Average NICU stay for a drug addicted baby is over 20 days.

### **Model Integrated MAT Program**

- 8 patient touches per month initially. No less than 4 touches per month.
- Employed physicians taper program
- Counseling
- Case Management/WRAP
- Peer Support
- Drug Screens
- Medication Counts


- Peer Support Training Program approved January 2016.

# **Boyd County Needle Exchange**

- •17 people entered treatment in 1<sup>st</sup> year.
- A decision to enter treatment every 13.25 hours the exchange was open.
