UNITE Clubs

- School anti-drug clubs
- Help youth develop healthy attitudes and behaviors by learning and practicing life skills; enhancing academic performance; connecting peers, adults and communities; and learning through service
- Conduct activities designed to help make their schools and communities healthy and drug-free
- Mentor younger students











Accidental Dealer Anyone who unknowingly provides access to prescription or over-the-counter medications to individuals who may enter their home 70% of teens obtain their drugs from family members or friends often without their consent
