One in five persons diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease actually have LATE (Limbic associated TDP-43 encephalopathy), formerly known as Hippocampal Sclerosis of Aging. **SMArT-HS** is a phase IIa study to assess the safety and tolerability of nicorandil (currently commonly used for chest pain) in people who are 75 years old or older with memory complaints.

physical exam, memory testing,
blood work and oral medication
8-10 visits over 2 years
