One in five persons diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease actually have LATE (Limbic associated TDP-43 encephalopathy), formerly known as Hippocampal Sclerosis of Aging. *SMArT-HS* is a phase IIa study to assess the safety and tolerability of nicorandil (currently commonly used for chest pain) in people who are 70 years old or older with memory complaints.

8-10 visits over 2 years
