

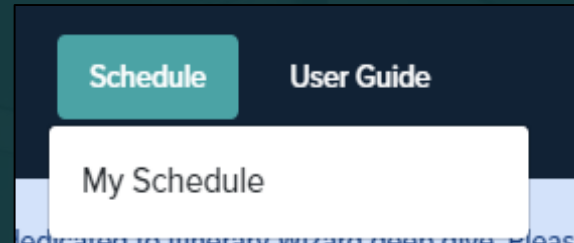

STEP 1 : VIEWING YOUR SCHEDULE IN THALAMUS

STEP 3 : PRIORTO INTERVIEWS

You will be sorted into your interview breakout room

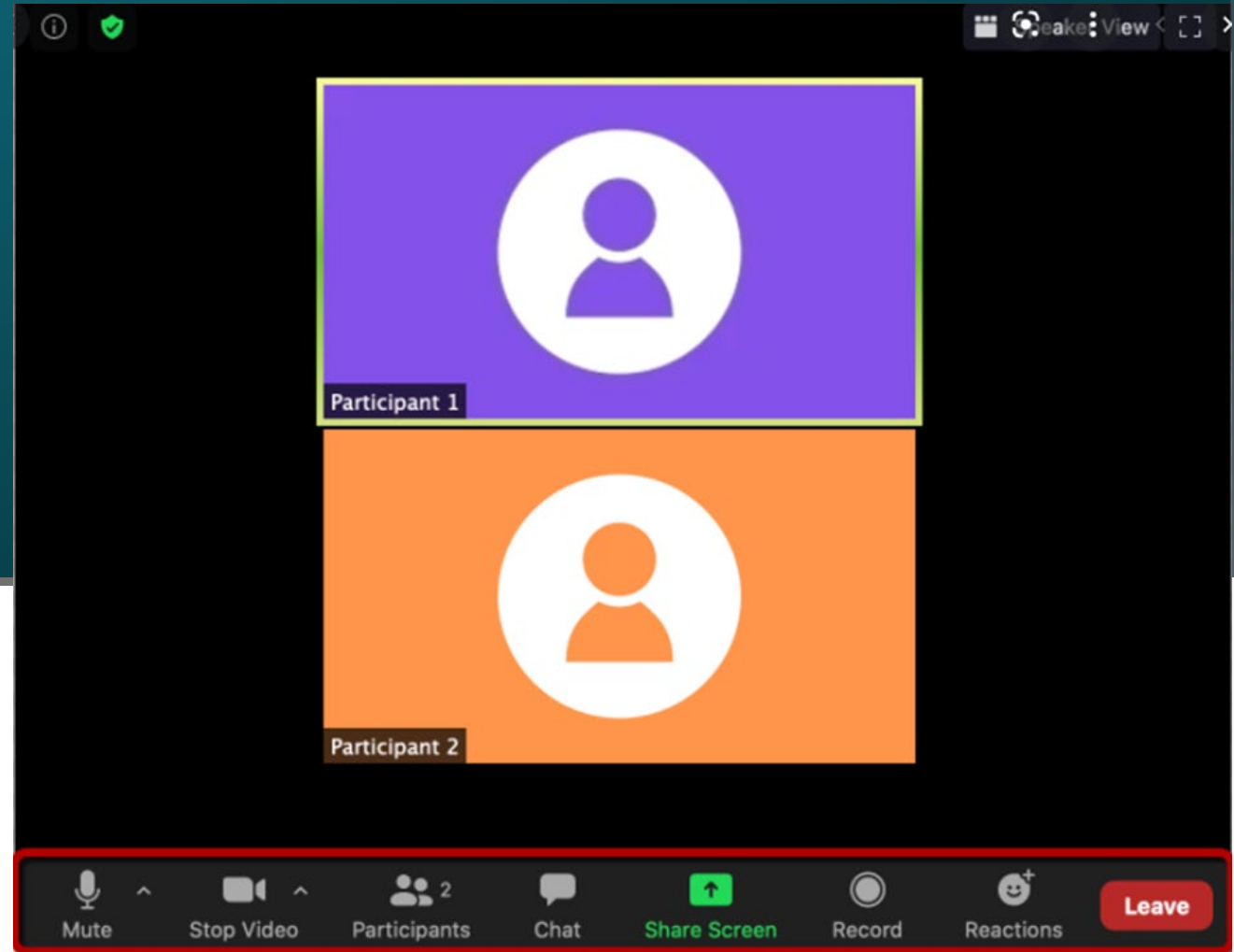


STEP 4 : INTERVIEWS

Once you have joined the meeting, you will have 20 minutes to interview. You will be sent notifications at the 5 and 0 minute remaining marks. Should you go over 5 minutes past the end time, the meeting will be manually ended.

Once ended you'll return to the main room.

Note: if you need assistance from the coordinator, please use the “invite” button to invite them into the room to assist. The chat in a breakout room cannot be seen by those in the main lobby / other breakout rooms.



THINGS TO KNOW

Lunch

Lunch is offline to allow each candidate to eat/take a break/prepare for their interviews. You will not be online or in zoom during this time.

THINGS TO KNOW (CON'T)

Breaks

You get (2) 20 minute breaks where you will be staying in the main room with the program coordinator and a resident (you will not be sorted into a breakout room). This is a great time to ask questions, make conversation, and rest between interviews. Don't stress, we're here to help!

THINGS TO KNOW (CON'T)

*10 minute
intervals between
interviews*

You get ~10 minutes between each interview to decompress, grab some water, etc. During this time, you can mute/turn your camera off in the main room or make conversation, this is just the waiting period between interviews/breaks.

THINGS TO KNOW (CON'T)

*Informational
(end of day)*

This small segment at the end of the day will allow you all to ask any follow-up questions, make suggestions, or just chat with us prior to logging off. We welcome any feedback and want to say bye before we logoff!
